Biographical/Historical note

Franklin Beck, the subject of this paper, was born in North Carolina but grew up in Wilcox County, Alabama. He attended, but did not graduate from, the University of Alabama, later attending Georgetown University and Yale Law School. He was licensed to practice law in 1841, was elected circuit court judge in 1843, to the Alabama Legislature in 1853, and to the Alabama Secession Convention in 1861, after which he was elected Colonel of the 23rd Alabama Infantry Regiment, serving throughout the Civil War until he was killed in Tennessee.
