This collection consists of a typescript copy of Black's autobiography, "After The Fact: 20/20 Hindsight," copyrighted 1985-86. It covers Black's youth in Beatrice, Monroe County, Alabama, his upbringing, education, teaching career, and political life in Washington. It was subsequently published in 1987 by the *Washington Provider*. The collection also contains several clippings of Black's column "Upward Mobility," from the *Washington New Observer*, some correspondence, a resume, and an outline for the autobiography.
