Biographical / Historical

William Stokes Wyman was a professor of Latin and Greek (1855-1908), historian, and University librarian, and President (1901-1902) of the University of Alabama.

Wyman, son of Justus and Mary Amelia Stokes Wyman, was born on November 23, 1830, in Montgomery, Alabama. He received his AB degree in 1851 and AM in 1853 from The University of Alabama, and his LLD in 1882, also from The University of Alabama. He joined the faculty and remained there until 1902. He married Melissa A. Dearing of Tuscaloosa in December 29, 1853. The couple had four children: (1) Benjamin Leon; (2) William Stokes; (3) Charles Augustus; and (4) Alice Searcy. Wyman died on October 20, 1915.
